The youth committee president also represents the youth committee at relevant meetings, ensures officers are completing their tasks and offers support when appropriate, facilitates youth committee meetings, submits monthly blurbs to the MVAC newsletter editor and offers input for the allocation of MVAC funds for youth committee projects and activities. Additionally, the youth committee president will gain public speaking skills by giving a monthly report to MVAC at the general meetings held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday each month.
