Happy New Year! Mission Viejo Activities Committee is hosting the 3rd annual Spring Boutique! This event is for hand crafted items only. The Spring Boutique showcases specialty items for Home Decor, Mother's Day, Father's Day, Graduates, Wedding Season and Summer. And this year the show is *before* Easter!

This is a juried show. What does that mean?

A jury reviews the **photographs** you submit and based on those **photographs**, and those **photographs** alone, 80 vendors will be selected for the show. It is <u>important</u> that your photographs be clear representations of your products.

All applications must be received by 6 PM, February 14th, 2025.

We ask that you follow the enclosed rules and regulations. You are required to submit a photocopy of your Seller's Permit. Make sure your application is signed and dated. Incomplete applications will not be judged.

❖ POLICIES AND JUDGING PROCEDURE ❖

Please submit: 5 photos of your merchandise and 1 photo of YOU creating YOUR item in YOUR workspace. The Spring Boutique Committee will judge the week of February 17th. All mailed in photographs become the property of the Mission Viejo Activities Committee.

BOOTH FEE IS NOT DUE UNTIL YOU ARE NOTIFIED OF ACCEPTANCE.

*All merchandise will be judged on the following criteria:

- A. Quality
- B. Presentation
- C. Creativity
- D. Adherence to Handcrafted Policy
- E. Uniqueness
- F. Overall Appeal to Judges
- G. Balance of Merchandise for Boutique (e.g. limits on certain categories)

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF USE:

The Mission Viejo Activities Committee reserves the right to remove, <u>without refund</u>, any person and/or merchandise not complying with the following regulations:

- A. All items must be **created by you**; no wholesalers or sales reps. **Absolutely NO wholesale.** manufactured or imported merchandise allowed, no exceptions.
- B. All items must be appropriate to the spirit of a family-oriented sale.
- C. MVAC is not responsible for damage to merchandise or cancellation of the Boutique in whole or part due to fire, windstorm, lightning, rain or any other inclement weather. MVAC spends substantial sums in preparation and advertisement of this event and refunds for spaces cannot be made in the event the Boutique is cancelled in whole or in part by such Acts of God.
- D. Theft of work: Although this rarely happens, theft does sometimes occur at the events. Mission Viejo Activities Committee and the NP Murray Community Center cannot be held liable by exhibitors for theft that may occur during the event.
- E. MVAC reserves the right to change the show layout or space locations if it becomes necessary.
- F. MVAC does not provide tables, chairs, electricity, fixtures, or supplies.
- H. Set up for the Boutique will be between 4:00 PM and 9:00 PM on Friday, April 4, 2025.
 - N. Vendors are to remain at the event from 8 AM to 4 PM. This is important to both the customers and the aesthetics of the event. Vendors not complying with this will be removed from the mailing list and will not be asked to participate again.
- J. All applications must be **received by 6 PM, February 14**th, 2025, to be considered for booth space by jury selection. Entries postmarked after the deadline will be held for the second round of judging should there be one.
- K. <u>If two crafters wish to share a booth, EACH crafter must submit a completed application and photos for judging.</u>
- L. Every effort is made to place crafters in spaces that complement one another. Our goal is that as your customers are shopping, they view each booth "with fresh eyes".
- M. MVAC is a non-profit volunteer group and our goal is to run a show that is fun as well as profitable for both crafters and MVAC. As important as the search for artistic talent is, we do not lose sight of the need for artists who are cooperative and easy to work with. Please be kind to our volunteers. Thank you!
- N. **FOOD PRODUCTS**: If you are vendor selling a food product (homemade candy, seasonings, jams, etc.) please check with the Orange County Health Department (ochealthinfo.com) to make sure that you are in compliance with the latest rules and regulations (**permits**). During the past few years these requirements have become strictly enforced and we want your Boutique experience to be a good one.



Frequently Asked Questions

- **1.** What is a juried show?
 - a. We will have a panel of Committee members (odd number) judge your submitted pictures to see who best meets the criteria.
- **2.** Does MVAC provide tables or chairs?
 - a. No, it is the vendors responsibility.
- **3.** How many pictures of my product(s) do I need to submit? Does 1 picture specifically need to be of me in my workspace making my item?
 - a. 6 total, yes, 1 MUST be of maker in workspace.
- **4.** Does MVAC provide electricity?
 - a. No, there is no guarantee that that there will be an outlet in your space, however, there are many spaces that do have outlets.
- **5.** Can I add items not pictured if I am chosen as a vendor?
 - a. Upon approval by the MVAC Boutique Committee.
- **6.** Can I share a space with another vendor?
 - a. Yes, however, the 2 vendors must apply and be approved individually. There will be NO additional space provided. Both vendors must fit in 1 space.
